The show took place on Tuesday , December 17th in Theatre of Senart . Mam was created by the dancers compagny "Teac Damsa" and has performed for 5 years now . The show is not a story in itself , but it is more a certain an invitation to dive into the irish culture tradition , music and dance playing on human universal emotions that evolves during the show .

This leads us to wonder a culture that we barely know and even though succed to gather us in such way that

allowed us to fully enjoy it and touched us deeply emotionally . The show in itself is made of 2I dancers who come from all around the world and who have spent over 8 weeks together in Ireland in the roots of the Irish cluture to as closer to it and it genuialy works!

Indeed , one of the most powerful things , is that the dancers seemed very closed to each others which create a kind of magic floating in the air and that was wonderful to watch and feel . According to Rachel , who is one of the dancers , there was any rules or special goal for the creation of the show : "We just gathered , danced, day after day we kept the best moves made by each of us and thisis how the piece was created " .The fact that the show has been together like a puzzle made the show more alive and the public felt more intriged and relaxed to fully enjoy the moment .

The last scene was a powerful moment to watch with sad and nostalgic music, in the background and the whole group together, as if it were their last time. When we asked Rachel about this scene, she said "you know, it's on your own to interprate it ". This freedom to interpretation allowed us to personally wonnect to the show and to participate in it.
